Academic Exchange with Singapore Polytechnic

Oita Kosen has had a cultural exchange with Singapore Polytechnic (SP) since 2007. And we have been trying to promote another academic exchange with the students at SP since 2009.

In 2010, 15 students at the Civil Engineering Department went to visit Singapore for an educational exchange with the students of the School of Architecture and the Built Environment at SP. During their 7-day stay in mid summer, our students and the SP students performed a lot of experiments on civil engineering, made a study visit to the latest purifying facility and entered a competition to design earthquake-proof buildings. They also enjoyed sightseeing, shopping and going out for Singaporean food together.
